Table #2—Online Registration

- Place on table the Pack's unique BeAScout.org QR Code directing families to online applications.
- Provide a phone/tablet if parent does not have one. Instruct parents on how to complete the online application for both youth and adults.
- Ask parents to complete the process at a separate table. When complete, direct families to Table #3 to check out.
- If parents are not ready to sign up and want more information, direct them to Table #4 where a Pack leader can help answer questions.
